

Accra Polo Club Riding Academy – Terms & Conditions

Term Dates: 15th August – 31st October 2025

1. Registration & Payment

- All students must **confirm participation by Friday**, **8th August 2025** by completing the online registration form.
- Full payment is due by Wednesday, 13th August 2025.
 - o Riding and Polo Playing Members: \$250
 - Social & Sports Members: \$500
 - o Non-Members: \$1000
- Payments are non-refundable unless cancellation is made in writing on or before
 Wednesday 20th August 2025 and approved by the Academy Committee.

2. Lesson Allocation

- Students will be assigned to specific lesson blocks based on ability level and availability.
- Once assigned, **lesson times remain fixed for the duration of the term**. Changes can only be made at the **discretion of the Academy** and are subject to slot availability.
- Each student will have 2 scheduled lessons per week.
- Students will be grouped by ability (beginner, intermediate, advanced) and assigned to available lesson slots on a first-come, first-served basis.

3. Attendance & Punctuality

- Riders are expected to arrive at the stables **10 minutes before their scheduled lesson time** to ensure they are mounted and ready to start promptly.
- Late arrivals may not be permitted to join the lesson, it will be at the coach's discretion. If permitted, the lesson will still end at the originally scheduled time to respect the next group's schedule.

4. Missed Lessons & Make-Ups

- If a student cannot attend a lesson, advance notice must be given via WhatsApp to the Academy Office.
- Make-up lessons will be provided at designated times throughout the term, but cannot be guaranteed for all missed sessions.
- Where the Academy cancels or reschedules a lesson, we will provide as much advance notice as possible and communicate changes via the Academy WhatsApp group. In these cases, a make-up lesson will be offered.

5. Communication

 All official communications (e.g., cancellations, updates, schedule changes) will be made through the Academy WhatsApp group. Parents and students are expected to monitor this channel regularly.
